LOCATION

Challock Gliding club on A252 Charing to Canterbury road

- 1 Course will consist of 3 laps of 13 sections (Observers permitting).

For this Trial to go ahead it requires you the riders, the organisers and most **importantly observers.**
Please help make this trial a success by bringing riders and Observers
On the day entries accepted, £15 adults, £10 youths.
- 2 **Start time 10.00am, two riders per 1 minute interval.**
Expert and Red route riders to section 1, Blue and Elite riders to section 8
Riders deviating from the course or ignoring signs and instructions will be disqualified.
Parking is located at the side of a public highway. Please push all bikes to the start line.

The Elite course will be marked with yellow flags where it deviates from the white Expert course.
- 3 Please ensure you bring adequate fuel as the course is longer than most other trials.
Fuel will not be available at the start.(Also see point 9 below)
- 4 Hot and Cold Food and Drink **WILL** be available care of BRM catering.
- 5 **ACU licences** to be shown when signing on.
- 7 **PLEASE NOTE THIS TRIAL IS BEING RUN UNDER THE NO STOP PERMITTED RULE.**
- 8 Please ensure dogs are kept on leads and spectators keep to the route marked
- 9 **Parking. Public Highway**
Please park responsibly to enable emergency vehicles and other traffic access to the gliding club. Parking is on the side of a public highway so please push bikes to the start area. People riding up and down the public highway who are not fully road traffic legal will be excluded.
The Gliding club facilities are used by the road traffic POLICE regularly.

- 10 **1st Aid** boxes will be positioned at the start, section 1 and section 13.
